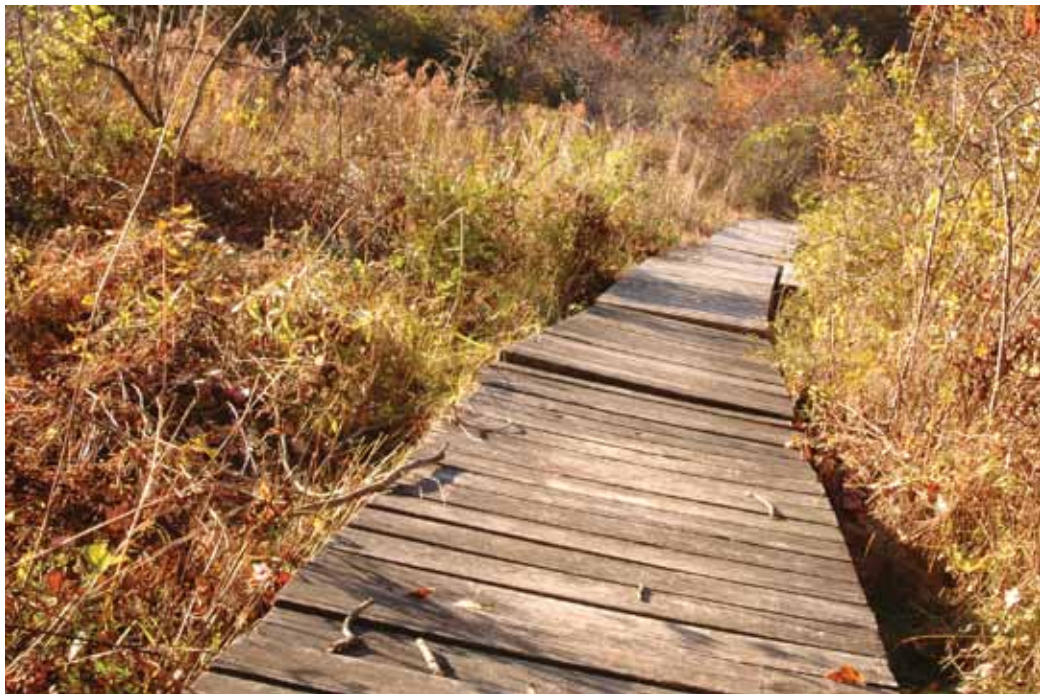

One Pastor's Thoughts



Have you ever had a very positive and powerful experience, one in which you felt you were on top of the world, followed by difficult and soul searching experience and cried out, "God, what are you doing to me?" The Bible says about Jesus, "He was tempted in every way as we are." You have never had an experience that Jesus hasn't already experienced. He's been on top of the mountain. He has walked through the "valley of the shadow of death."

Jesus searched for the best way to begin his earthly ministry. He chose to associate himself with his cousin John the Baptist by submitting to baptism in the Jordan River. The scripture says that when Jesus came up out of the water, heaven opened up, the Holy Spirit descended in the form of a dove and God spoke, "This is my son with whom I am well pleased." Since the name of our church is Trinity, we need to learn and claim powerful Trinitarian experiences. God in three persons, blessed Trinity – Jesus' baptism is such a moment.

Jesus had to be on top of the world. This was the way it was supposed to begin. Then, the Holy Spirit (of all things) led him into the wilderness of Judea to be tempted by the devil. No honeymoon, no pleasant transition – just led him into the wilderness. There he fasted for 40 days and 40 nights. A typical fast was refraining from eating during daylight hours. Jesus fasted during the day and during the night! From the top of the mountain to the depths of temptation, the devil tempted Jesus three times.

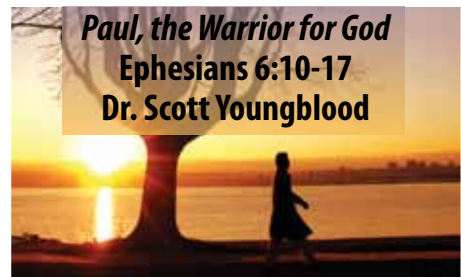
THIS IS LENT. Lent is modeled on Jesus' 40 days and nights in the wilderness. Lent is the 40 days before Easter not counting Sundays. Wednesday night during our Ash Wednesday Service, I challenged all of us to "Unlock the power of Lent." If you allow yourself to identify with Jesus in Lent, then you too can unlock the power of Lent. Don't rush into Easter. Don't miss the power of this season called Lent. We are tempted to move quickly to the celebration of the Resurrection, but the Resurrection holds no power until you experience the wilderness of crucifixion. God cannot raise those who have not fallen.

Once a year, during *One Great Hour of Sharing*, our congregation, along with other United Methodist congregations, participate in this special effort. When catastrophes cause suffering in our world, the offering that our church and other United Methodist churches receive is designated to help the most vulnerable by bringing healing, hope, and a place of refuge.

Entering Into Lent on Sunday Mornings

Dr. Scott's cover article reminds us of the scriptural and spiritual significance of Lent. Our Worship Committee has tried to find ways to facilitate our congregational journey through the season. You may be most aware of two elements, and we pray you find them edifying. 1) The pre-service subdued lighting and the quiet music as we enter the Sanctuary provides an opportunity for us to approach and prepare for worship differently, in this time of repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of Easter. 2) Through the season, the Sanctuary cross will be draped with a variety of different colors, helping us mark the passage of time as we move through Lent to Easter. For Ash Wednesday and the First Sunday of Lent, we use grey, to mark the beginning of this season of prayer and fasting. Grey unsettles us, creates expectations within us, and signifies mourning and repentance, helping to reflect the mood of penitence and reflection. The length of fabric itself which drapes the cross recalls the traditional means by which bodies were lowered from the cross.
